

RULES FOR CAMPAIGNING

All campaign materials require written Committee approval prior to distribution. Campaign materials will be given directly to the committee chairperson, by the candidate, along with a cover letter requesting that the committee review the material and approve it for release. The means of distribution must also be stated in the letter, i.e., U.S. mail, Stonegate community email, Stonegate Community Center in-house placement.

Campaign materials may not be posted on the bulletin boards, placed in outside information boxes, posted on any sign, or delivered door-to-door.

The following disclaimer must appear at the top of each campaign piece in 18 pt. bold type:

THE FOLLOWING IS NOT AN ENDORSEMENT BY THE STONEGATE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, OR THE NOMINATION AND ELECTION COMMITTEE. THE INFORMATION WAS SUBMITTED BY AND IS THE EXPRESSED OPINION OF THE CANDIDATE.

The disclaimer will also be included in the cover letter preceding any resident emailing of campaign material made by the Stonegate Community Association.

U.S. Mail – The candidate may provide campaign materials, plus envelopes, to the Executive Director who will instruct staff to label envelopes, stuff, seal, and add postage. The candidate will be billed, at a rate established by the Board of Directors, for all costs incurred by the Association.

Resident Email – The Association will email campaign material using its residents list. The candidate will be responsible for any expenses (staff time/material/outside services) incurred by the Association.

Community Center Distribution – Only one piece of campaign material, no larger than 8.5"x11" may be presented for approval. Once approved, the candidate will deliver copies to the Executive Director for placement in a designated area of the Community Center.

Campaigning is limited to the above, unless approved by the committee.

Any variance to the above will be offered to all candidates.

I have read the above rules regarding campaigning within Stonegate, and I agree to comply with them and be bound by them. Violations thereof may result in sanctions and/or removal from the Ballot.
