

COVID-19 Recommendations

The Stonegate Community Association Board of Directors agrees with our Executive Director's recommendations on how SCA should handle business during the COVID-19 outbreak. In order to minimize the spread of COVID-19 and to protect our members and staff during this period, the following items will be implemented.

- 1) The Annual Meeting and the Board Meeting scheduled for March 26th have been canceled. Voting for Board Candidates ends Monday, March 23rd at 5 p.m. The Nomination & Election Committee will meet Tuesday, March 24th. The election results will be announced by community email.
- 2) Board and Committee meetings are canceled at this time. SCA has contracted with Zoom for audio-video conferencing of future Board meetings. Members can join Board meetings via a provided link as to comply with open meeting requirements. Committee meetings will use the audio-video conferencing to conduct their business and to make recommendations to the Board.
- 3) The Community Center will be closed Monday, March 23rd for a period of 30 days for all daytime and weekend events.
- 4) The Community Center will be closed to walk-in traffic for the next 30 days. Residents are requested to call 480-391-9760 to schedule an appointment or leave a message and a staff member will contact you. Appointments will take place between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Most community association business will take place via the phone and e-mail.
- 5) The main gate will be manned 24/7. We are requesting residents to pre-admit all guests and vendors in order to keep gate personnel contact and exposure to a minimum. Please provide your guest and vendor the following address: 11551 East Mountain View Road so they arrive at the main gate and not the East Gate.
- 6) The outside recreational areas will remain open during their normal operating hours. Residents are responsible for their guests and their behavior. SCA is requesting residents abide by the rule of 8 people or less. At this time, Maricopa County Health Department states the virus is killed by the pool or spa chlorinated water. SCA maintenance personnel are disinfecting the recreational area and equipment. Tennis and pickleball continues. Please use the reservation system.
- 7) Spring Fling is postponed.

The above actions are designed to minimize gathering and to allow the reasonable use of the recreation area. A restriction on outdoor exercise has not occurred as individuals do maintain social distancing. Yes, we are living in interesting times and this crisis will end.
