

Recreational Amenities To Close

The Board of Directors held an emergency Executive Session to review and discuss the Arizona Governor's Executive order mandating a 30-day stay at home during the Covid-19 pandemic. The Governor's order allows for essential businesses to continue working. Stonegate Community Association qualifies as an essential business.

The Board discussed in depth the Governor's order, the recreational actions of other municipalities and community associations, and written advice from the Association's attorney. After careful consideration including the safety of the members, safety of staff, potential liability issues, and in the best interest of the community as a whole, the Board has taken the action to close all Recreational Amenities.

- The Recreational Amenities will be closed starting Friday, April 3rd at 3 p.m. The following amenities will be affected:
 - Pool
 - Spa
 - Bathhouses
 - Tennis Courts
 - Pickleball Courts
 - Playground
 - Basketball Court

Signs will be posted and locks will be placed on amenities where appropriate.

- Maintenance will work Monday through Friday but are working shorter hours. Orders for SOS will be taken for outside work only and depending on maintenance's workload. Indoor requests will not be taken at this time.
- The Main Gate will continue to operate 24/7 for access control. Please use your discretion to limit who you allow access into the community. Please pre-admit your visitors and vendors as to lessen the exposure for the gate personnel.
- The Community Center is operating with doors locked and by appointment only. Some of the Association business is being conducted by email, phone and Zoom, an audio/video application. Additional changes in administrative operations will be reported shortly.

The action taken by the Board of Directors is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the community and staff. These actions will be reconsidered after May 1st.
