Pickleball Rules and Guidelines

Residents must register with SCA for access to the online reservation system.

To make an online reservation, go to <u>www.Stonegate-Scottsdale.com</u>. Click on the Tennis/Pickleball reservation link.

Hours for the Pickleball courts are 8:30 a.m. until 7 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:30 a.m. until 6 p.m. Saturday & Sunday. Lights will automatically turn off at 7 p.m. Monday through Friday and at 6 p.m. on Saturday & Sunday. Anyone using this recreational amenity outside of the recreational hours, or entering improperly at any time, will be considered trespassing.

Please contact Stonegate Community Association at 480-391-9760 for suggestions to improve your recreational experience, report a maintenance issue, a non-compliance issue, or have any concerns.

- 1. One reservation per day, per lot up to 90 minutes. Reservations can be made up to 3 days in advance.
- 2. Only 2 reservations per lot are allowed each week during the hours of 5:30 p.m. –7p.m.
- 3. Residents making the reservation must be present and participating on the court before guests are permitted to play.
- 4. Court cancellations must be made at least 2 hours prior to the scheduled time.
- 5. All Players on the court must be entered into the reservation system with a maximum of (4) players. If using a pro, the pro must be selected when making the reservation.
- 6. SCA reserves the right to delete a reservation if incomplete. One email warning notice will be sent; afterwards a reservation will be deleted without notice.
- 7. Clinics and lessons are limited to four (4) players and the pro.
- 8. Residents are responsible for their guest's and pro's conduct. Residents are required to have their pro register with SCA, complete the application and provide evidence of liability insurance prior to teaching or giving clinics.
- 9. If a non-registered pro is found to be teaching on the courts, the name of the resident should be reported to SCA.
- 10. If a resident schedules a court and is more than 10 minutes late, the court is forfeited and available to another resident to play with no reservation needed.
- 11. Proper attire is required. Shirts and non-marking court shoes must be worn. No cleats, flip-flops, sandals or bare feet are permitted.
- 12. No food, drinks or alcoholic beverages are allowed on the courts. Water and sports drinks are allowed in plastic or sports containers. No glass allowed.
- 13. Please keep our courts clean and beautiful. Remove all debris and place in trash bins.
- 14. Pickleball courts are for Pickleball only. NO pets, skates, rollerblades, bicycles, go-peds, skateboards, or other non-pickleball items are permitted.
- 15. No music is allowed.
- 16. No unsportsmanlike conduct, yelling, profanity or throwing of equipment is permitted.
- 17. Court gates must be locked upon leaving the court.
- 18. Children 13 years old and younger must be with a parent or guardian, 18 years or older.
- 19. Residents & guests must show a photo ID with the name that matches the reservation, if asked by a SCA staff member.
- 20. No tailgating parties on any of SCA's common areas.
- 21. Respect all neighboring properties.
