

## Pool and Spa Rules & Regulations

### **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY– SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK – NO DIVING ALLOWED**

*Hours for the Recreational Amenities area are 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. daily. Lights will automatically shut off at 10:15 p.m. Anyone using the recreational facilities outside of the recreational hours, or entering improperly at any time, will be considered trespassing.*

*The pool and spa facilities are for the enjoyment of the Stonegate residents and their guests. The Community Association reserves the right to schedule the pool for special events and classes. The following posted rules must be followed. All City and County ordinances apply.*

*Please contact Stonegate Community Association at 480-391-9760 for suggestions to improve your recreational experience, report a maintenance issue, a non-compliance issue, or have any concerns.*

1. Gates must remain closed. Do not prop gates open.
2. Persons with cuts, infections or illness shall be excluded from the pool/spa.
3. Shower and use the restroom before entering the pool/spa.
4. Children under 15 years old must be supervised by a parent or guardian, 18 years or older.
5. Adult supervision is required for groups of 6 or more that are under the age of 18.
6. Children under the age of 5 not permitted in the spa - due to health and safety concerns.
7. Proper swim attire required.
8. Swim diapers or rubber pants required for infants, or when necessary.
9. Only service animals permitted.
10. No glass – use plastic or non-breakable containers.
11. No food or drink in the pool/spa.
12. No music or loud noise.
13. No smoking.
14. No bikes/scooters/skates/skateboards inside – use racks at entry gate.
15. No offensive behavior or language.
16. No toys or floats in spa. The spa is for therapeutic purposes only.
17. No walking or playing in fountains.
18. No throwing of hard balls in the pool/spa or around the deck.
19. No running or horseplay.
20. Groups larger than 8 people must make a mini ramada reservation with the SCA office.
21. Put all trash in the receptacles.
22. Put umbrellas down when leaving.
23. Take personal belongings when leaving the area.
24. Residents are responsible for their guest's and instructor's conduct. Residents are required to have their instructor pre-register with SCA, complete the application and provide evidence of liability insurance prior to teaching or giving lessons.
25. Must show photo ID if requested by SCA Staff.
